

Hunt an Object, Change its Use!

Get those hunting hats on!

Instruct your child to find an object.

When they have found it, they have got to think of something else it could be used for. (You may have to help them at first.)

Carry on instructing them to find other objects for as long as you both are happy to do so.

Some examples

A saucepan – turn it into a drum.

An onion – turn it into a bowling ball.

Keys – turn them into a necklace.

A book – turn it into a hat.

(I bet you can do better than that!)
