How to play:

- Each person has to use their pieces to build a tower.
- Build individually you can ask friends or family to build their tower too.
- When all the towers have been built, show each other and describe your design.
- Compare features of the towers. Look at how they have been built; their heights, bases and colours used.
- Check each tower and think about the following questions:
- 1) Are each of the models a 'tower'?
- 2) Are they all the same? How are they different?
- If the models are different, but each is a tower, it means that there is more than one way to build something.
- Re-design your tower, adding further features that you liked about the other towers?
